## 1. How to Play

1. Place your bet, by choosing the amount on the bet button.
2. Press the button marked "Buy Ticket".
3. Reveal what is under the cloches. This can be done two ways. You can either click on each cloche or you can remove them all by clicking on the 'Open All' button.
4. Once you have revealed what is hiding beneath the cloches, check to see if you've won. You can do this either by checking that there are 3 matching dishes or by looking at the left side bottom of the screen on the "Win" box.



## 2. Game Directions

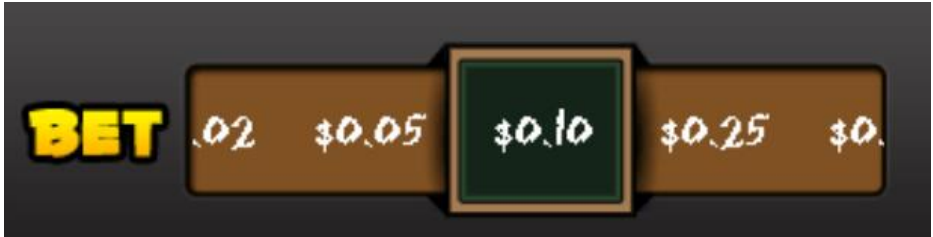
In order to play Cash Cuisine, first you need to place a bet. You can adjust the amount of your bet by choosing it on the bet display. Then you need to reveal the hidden plates. If you have three of the same symbol, you have won.

## 3. How to Read the Paytable

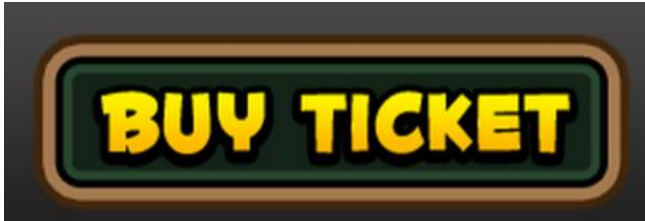
The Paytable in this game acts like a key, explaining the value of each symbol in the game. The win amount is determined based on bet amount x the payable multiplier.

## 4. Game Controls

Below is the Bet button. You can adjust the amount of your bet by choosing it on the bet display.



Below is the "Buy Ticket" button. This button is used to begin the game. Once you have selected your bet amount press "Buy Ticket" and the game will begin



## 5. A Look Inside

### 1. The starting screen
